TODAY we welcome you to our worship services. Today's message is "*Far Be It From You*" presented by local Pastor Valentine Roach. We pray that you receive a special blessing.

OUR CHURCH PROTOCOLS

Please be advised there are changes to the way we interact and worship together.

For us to comply with the Risk Assessment required by the SEC, we must adhere to the following guidelines :-

1. You may be required to queue before entering the building. Please arrive early.
2. A face mask/shield *must* be worn at all times.
3. Sanitization stations are available for use throughout the building.
4. A temperature check will be taken on arrival.
5. Your contact Information (name and phone number) must be collected so you can be notified in the event of a positive Covid-19 case.
6. Track and trace app usage – if you have the NHS Covid-19 app on your smart phone, you must scan it on your arrival at church.
7. Social distancing measures are in effect throughout the building.
8. Congregational singing is allowed whilst wearing your facemask.
9. You will be directed to your seat on arrival and required to sit in your family bubble, or alone if you have no family members with you.
10. You will be ushered out of the building at the end of the service.
11. There are no water fountains, so please bring your own water bottles.
12. Tithes and offering collection – offering boxes are placed strategically in the sanctuary for you to return your tithes and freewill offerings, please listen for guidance on how this is collected.

IMPORTANT: If you feel unwell, have a cold, cough, fever, have had a recent positive test, or been in contact with anyone who has tested positive for Covid-19, you are advised to stay at home to reduce the risk of infecting others.
